

LARGE ITEM PICK-UP

Will be held **October 4th-October 7th**

Appliances Will Be Picked Up **THURSDAY, October 7th ONLY**

All neighborhoods should place items at the curb by 7 a.m. Monday, Oct 4.

Pick up is for larger items NOT usually picked up through weekly service.

There is a \$15 sticker fee for each appliance or electronic. Stickers need to be affixed to each appliance and/or electronic item and are available at **City Hall until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 6th.**

ITEMS REQUIRING A STICKER WILL BE PICKED UP THURSDAY.

Items that
require
a sticker
are:

- furnaces
- dehumidifiers
- dryers
- trash compactors
- air conditioners
- dishwashers
- microwaves
- fluorescent light fixtures
- refrigerators
- stoves
- copy machines
- televisions
- freezers
- washers
- water heaters
- computer monitors & printers.

ALL ITEMS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS...

50 LB. WEIGHT LIMIT PER ITEM!

- Bulky items that are difficult to handle, such as swing sets, garage doors **must be** cut up or dismantled into smaller sections.
- Appliances will be picked up, however, they will have to be empty.
- Refrigerator doors **MUST** be removed to eliminate an entrapment hazard to children.
- Toxic items cannot be collected, including chemicals, gasoline, gas tanks, fuels, propane tanks, pesticides, paint, tires & batteries.
- Limbs, brush or yard clippings **will not** be picked up.
- Construction materials, including concrete, from building renovations & refurbishings **will not** be picked up.

Trash and refuse that is normally handled by refuse haulers during weekly pick up **will not** be picked up.

Clear Lake Large Item Clean-up

Residents are encouraged to use this opportunity to dispose of items that cannot be discarded through their weekly garbage service. To ensure an efficient and orderly clean-up program, the City asks residents to follow these guidelines:

***All items must be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Monday** and be from addresses within the City limits. The City will not pick up in alleys. Do not place items in garbage cans, cardboard boxes, or plastic garbage bags. Items not picked up must be removed from the curb within 24 hours.

***Appliances are not collected free** during City wide cleanup. City residents can have old appliances and/or electronic items picked up for a cost of \$15 per item. Stickers, which need to be affixed to the item to be disposed of, can be purchased at Clear Lake City Hall, 15 N 6th Street. **STICKERS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.** Items requiring a sticker are: furnaces, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, stoves, washers, dryers, microwaves, trash compactors, copy machines, water heaters, fluorescent light fixtures, TV's, computer monitors and printers. Appliances should be intact for safe recovery of contaminants, except that doors should be removed from freezers and refrigerators.

The following items will not be picked up due to regulatory, environmental, or economic reasons:

***E-Waste (electronics).** The Landfill of North Iowa has an electronic waste recycling program. Landfill customers may drop off VCR's, DVD players, stereo equipment, clock radios, gaming equipment, computer towers, mice and keyboards, input devices, scanners, video and surveillance cameras, fax machines, and cordless phones for recycling at the e-cycling building adjacent to the Landfill's south parking lot. Many of the above items may be recycled free of charge.

***NO Glass.** We will not pick up windows, glass shower doors, mirrors, etc.

***Fluorescent Light Bulbs** Please take fluorescent light bulbs to the Landfill for disposal.

***Yard waste** (grass, leaves, and garden residue) and **wood waste** (brush, branches and tree limbs less than 6" in diameter). These items may be taken to the City yard waste drop-off site and disposed of at no charge.

***Construction and demolition material** (windows, bricks, stones, concrete, concrete block or rubble, shingles, lumber, landscape timbers, siding, and drywall). City crews will take small amounts of dimensional lumber and drywall, less than 4 ft. in length and bundled (bundles less than 50 lbs).

***Liquids** (motor oil, antifreeze, paint, and household chemicals). Some service stations accept motor oil for recycling. Empty paint cans will be accepted if the drivers can see that the paint is dried or absorbed with a substance like cat litter or saw dust.

***Hazardous/toxic materials** (flammables, propane tanks, auto parts, tires, batteries, pesticides, explosives). Auto parts should be taken to an auto salvage yard. Propane tanks may be taken to area recyclers. Call the Landfill of North Iowa at 357-5452 for information regarding disposal of other hazardous substances.

The Clear Lake Large Item Pick-up is offered as a special service to Clear Lake residents only. The public is asked to call the Police Department at 357-2186 to report anyone from outside the Clear Lake City limits unloading items.
